Griffin presented the requested TIP amendments and schedule, facilitating discussion regarding bike/ped accommodations. John explained that the Round Rock FM1460 project's bike/ped facility designation now reads: "5 foot sidewalks along the entire length for pedestrians, and 14 foot outside lanes to accommodate bicyclists". Greg added that transit providers need not list a bike/ped accommodation to meet CAMPO policy, because they most often are not building new or reconstructing roadway, but that listing specific accommodations, if any, are beneficial.

2. Discussion / Recommendation: 2035 Plan Update Public Involvement

Griffin presented a draft "Public Involvement Process Summary", which lays out the process for involving the public in the upcoming 2035 Plan. The group confirmed the approach through discussion.

3. Other items

Sharon stated that a survey showed 95% agree that increased attention by road users could reduce crashes, and that a group was needed to promote public information regarding the need.

Presentation of requested amendments to CAMPO's FYs 2008 - 2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)	

BACKGROUND: CAMPO staff solicited requests for amendments to the CAMPO FYs 2008 – 2011 Transportation Improvement Program in June and July. Amendment requests have been made by Capital Metro, TxDOT, and the cities of Hutto, Leander, Pflugerville, and Round Rock. The requested amendments are shown in **Table 1**. **Table 2** shows the amendments CAMPO is addressing administratively.

The requested amendments will be the subject of a **September 8th Public Hearing** and could be **considered for adoption at the October 13th meeting**. The amendments will be presented at four community meetings for public review and comment at the following locations:
