What is the PPP?

The Public Participation Plan (PPP) is a document that guides CAMPO's public outreach and community input programs. CAMPO's PPP also includes examples of best practices to ensure an inclusive outreach program that accounts for a variety of demographics and needs throughout the six-county region.

Why is the PPP important?
