»»» What is the PPP?

The Public Participation Plan (PPP) is a document that **guides CAMPO’s public outreach and community input programs**. CAMPO’s PPP also includes examples of best practices to ensure an inclusive outreach program that accounts for a variety of demographics and needs throughout the six-county region.

»»» Why is the PPP important?

The PPP is the **guide to understanding when and how to get involved** with CAMPO’s planning and decision-making processes. It explains outreach methods that are required by CAMPO, and also outlines the higher standard that CAMPO uses to equitably engage people within the region.
