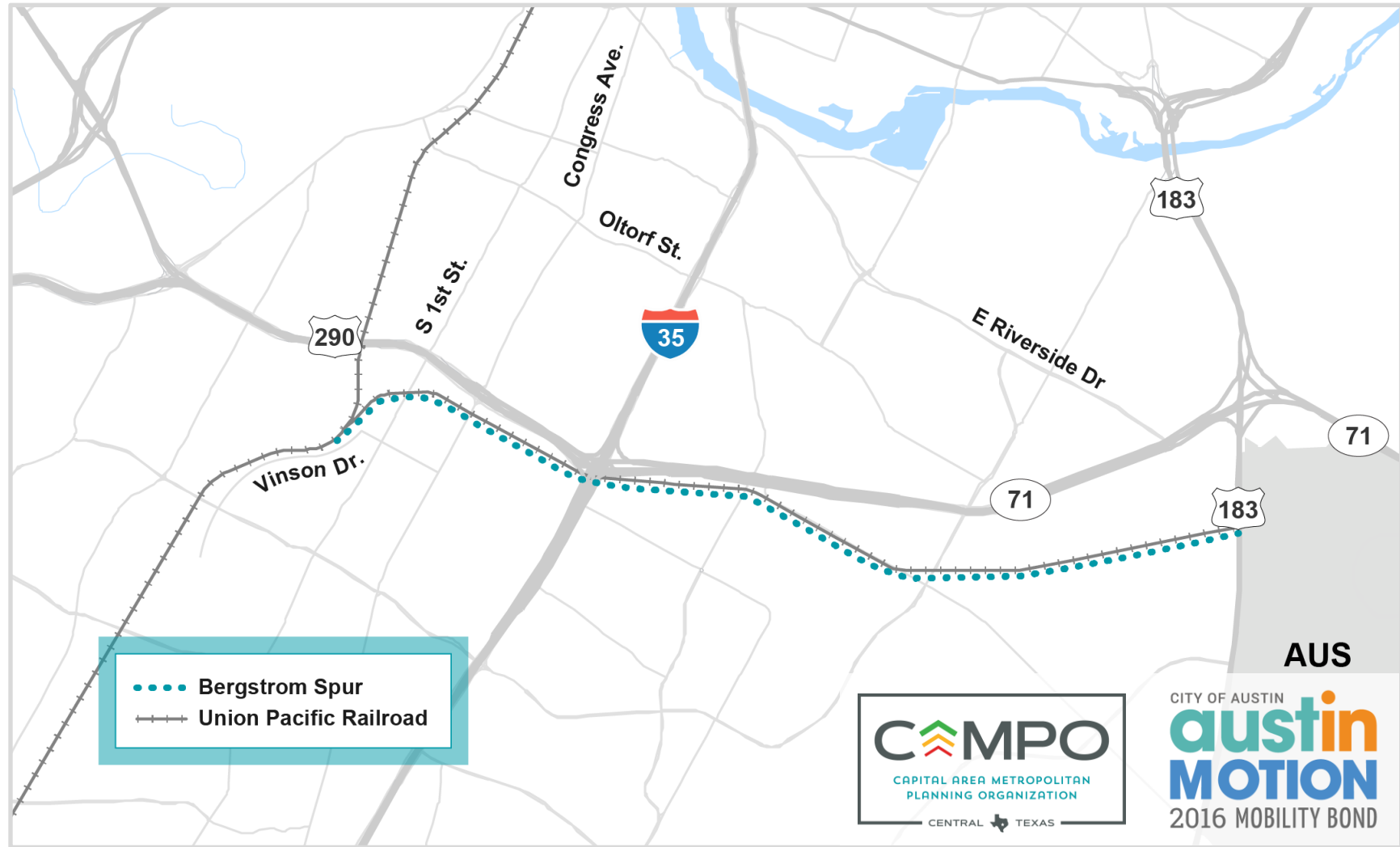

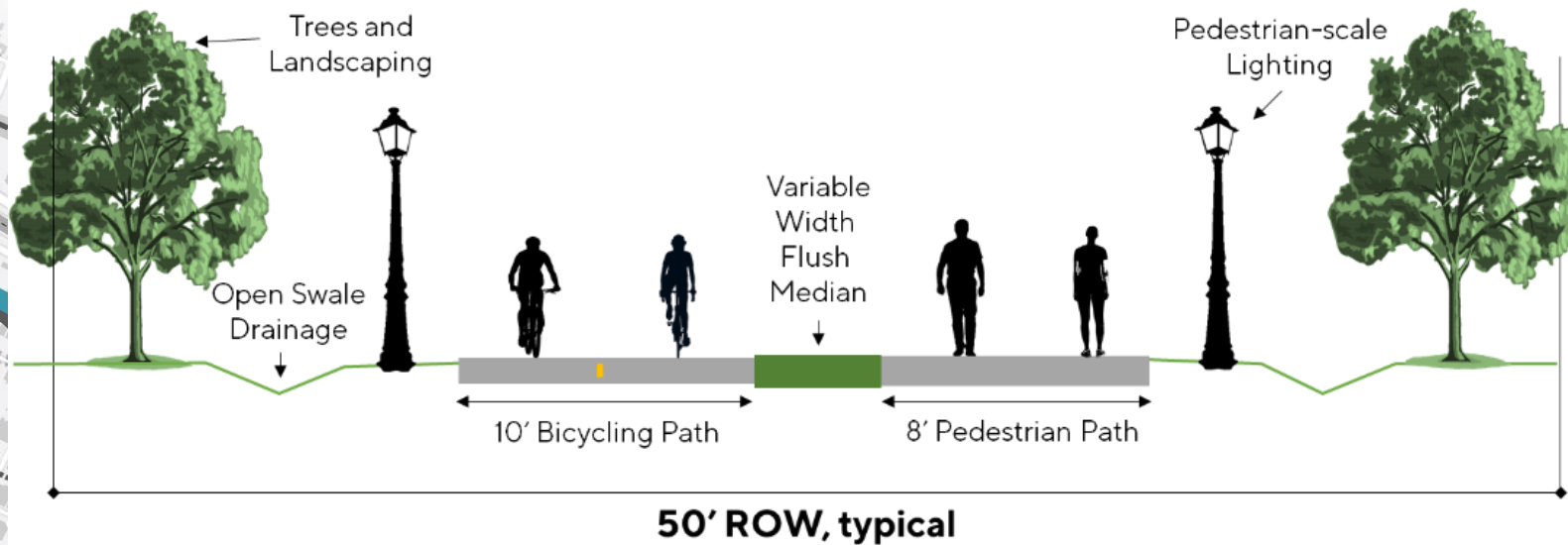

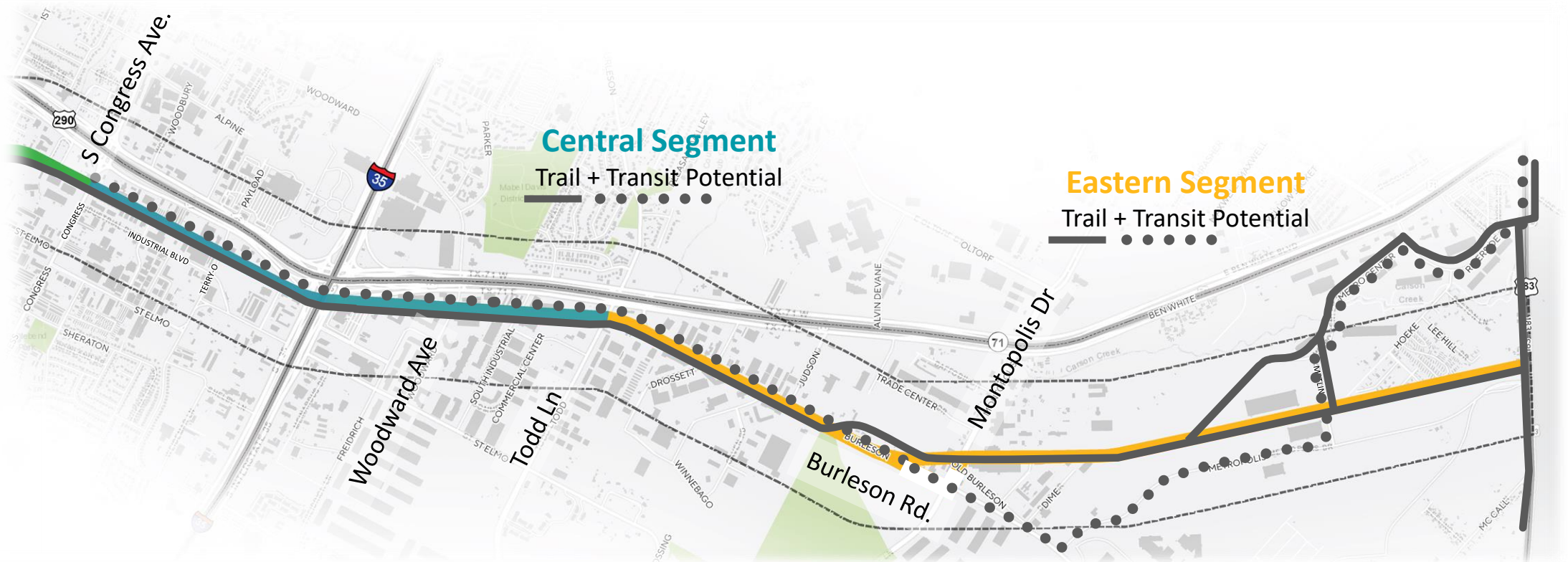

- Meetings with elected officials







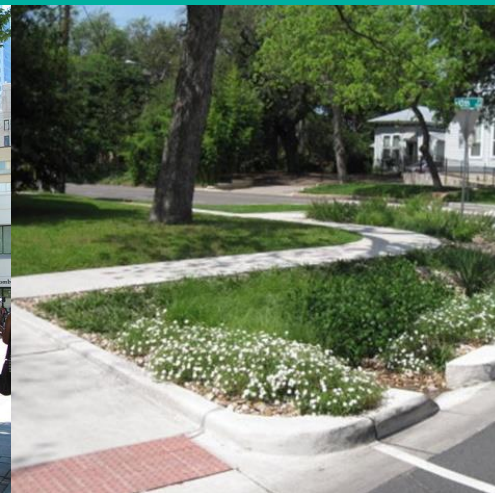

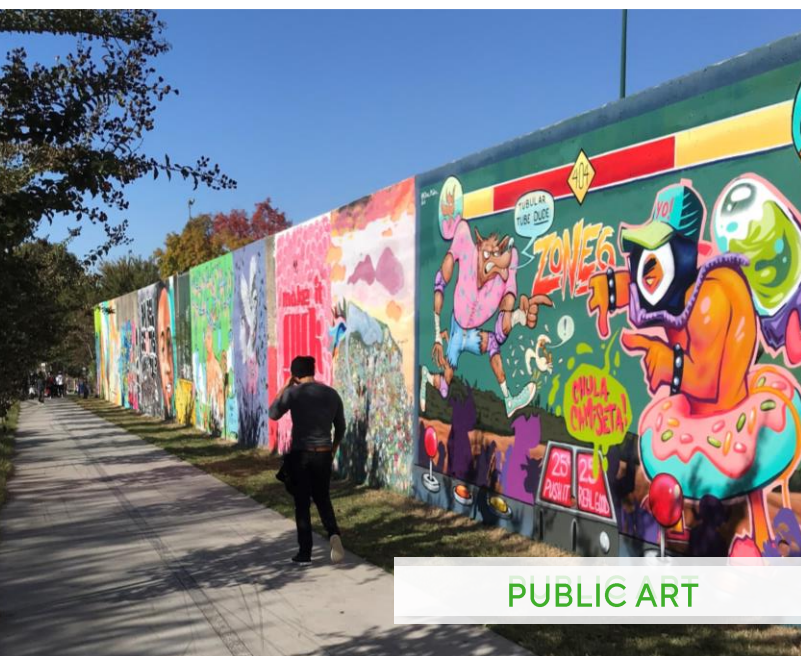

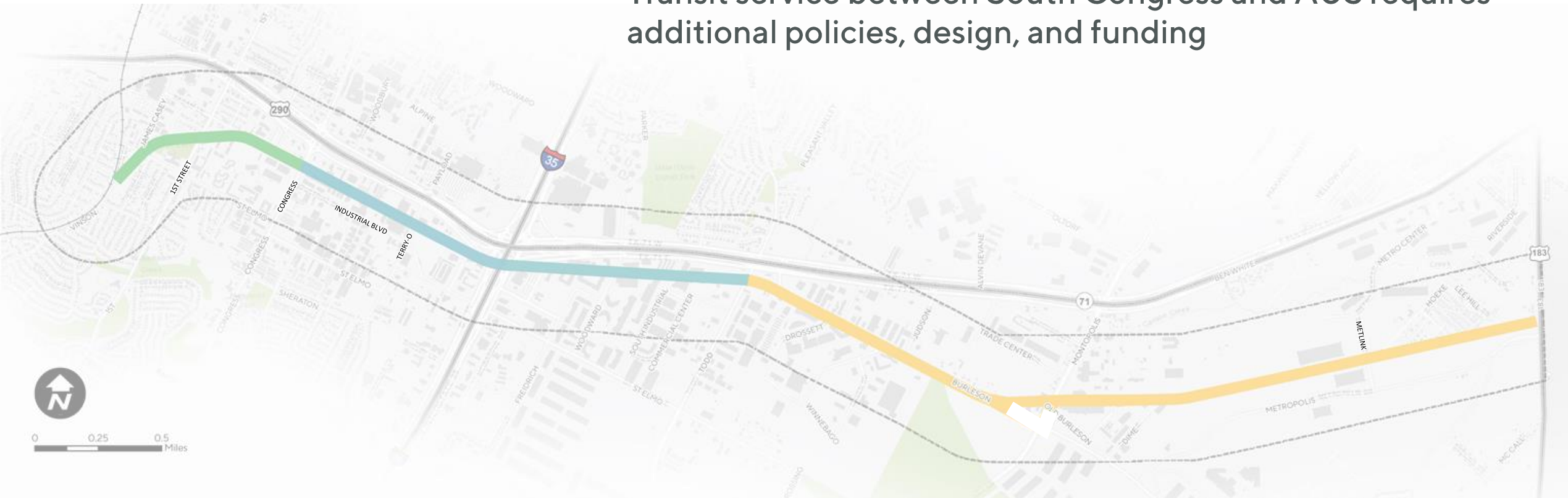






## Bergstrom Spur Platinum Planning Study Next Steps
